Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills (IOLS) training is a hands-on program which gives adult leaders the practical outdoor skills they need to lead Scouts in the out-of-doors. Imagine having hands-on knowledge of setting up a campsite, pitching a tent, hiking, outdoor cooking—all the skills necessary to see the outdoor program of the Boy Scouts of America come to life.

The skills sessions presented in IOLS closely follow the Boy Scout Handbook and are designed for all Scoutmasters, Assistant Scoutmasters, Committee Members, WEBELOS leaders, Varsity Scout leaders, Venturing leaders and others desiring to learn or improve outdoor Scouting skills. Mastering these skills allows leaders to become confident in the basic outdoor skills used by their Scouts through First Class rank. Each skills session connects with specific chapters in the Boy Scout Handbook.

Hands-on participation makes the best learning tool. Participants will be placed into patrols and operate using the patrol method during the course.

Scoutmasters and Assistants can complete Leader Specific Training by registering for the Friday evening session. Join us for the entire weekend and become fully trained for your position!
