Our open house will be held on **Tuesday, October 19th 6:30pm** at the Hancock County Sheriff's Office located at 200 W. Crawford Street, Findlay. At this meeting we will acquaint you with the Exploring program and answer any questions you may have regarding the activities and information provided. There will be an overview of the facilities and you may acquaint yourself with the different law enforcement divisions within the agency. Your parents are welcome to attend this first meeting.

Through this program students will be given hands on experience in crime scene investigation, patrol techniques, fingerprinting, K-9 handling, firearms handling and safety, how to conduct traffic stops, and more!
