Dear Unit Leaders, Volunteers and Scouts,

At the beginning of 2023 a Popcorn Steering Committee was formed to research ways to increase involvement of the Fall Product Sale and increase the amount of revenue earned and returned to Units within our Scouting Movement. Popcorn Kernels, Parent Volunteers, Leading Sellers and Council Leadership formed the committee, which met three times.

A survey was developed to reach out to our Units that sold Popcorn in 2022 and Units that did not sell in 2022. We had a great response to the survey with over 60 individuals who responded. The results showed many different aspects that the committee felt could be improved in the 2023 Fall Product Sale. These included: starting earlier to recruit more help from parents and volunteers, better range of products offered, lower shipping costs, increased training and further use of technology in sales, improved incentives, strong kick offs and improved communication.

As a result of the survey an additional licensed vendor was sought out to see if they were interested in our 2023 Popcorn Sale, but they were at capacity for the year and could not add an additional sale. Trail's End, our current vendor was contacted, and their Sales Leadership met with the Popcorn Steering Committee to hear the concerns addressed in the survey and discuss opportunities for this year's sale. Trail's End has some exciting opportunities that will be a great asset to our sale. They are currently working on securing Storefront Opportunities and will have an online process that will allow Units to secure their storefronts for selling, including some new stores. They are committed to lowering the cost of shipping and have a few items that are being offered at a lower price point. We are excited about what they have to offer and look forward to making this year's sale a huge success.
